CERTIFICATE

I. Name of Society :- Name of this society is Sreekrishnapuram Educational Society or Sreekrishnapuram Vidhyabhyasa Society.

II. Aims or Object of the Society:- Temporarily constituted committee as in the name of Sreekrishnapuram High School Committee was legally named as "Sreekrishnapuram Vidhyabhyasa Society" and its aims that to run the Sreekrishnapuram High School in good manner and construct and maintain institutions for achieving the prosperity, Social, Educational and Cultural acquiring and dealing for the development of the resided people of the locality.

III. The members of the Managing Committee who are the responsible for the governing as per the rules and regulations of the society and the names and position of the members of the Managing Committee are shown below.

2. Shri. K.P. Kunhiruman Kurup (Vice-President)
3. Shri. M.K. S. Raman (Secretary)
4. Shri. P.C. Chitrabhama Namboothiripad (Executive Member)

6. Shri. C.T. Chokkurri Thirakan (Executive Member)
7. Shri. P. Appukuttan Mannadiar (Executive Member)
8. Shri. N.C. Subramaniam Namboothiri (Executive Member)
9. Shri. M. Krishnan Nair (Executive Member)

MEMBERSHIP

a) Those who are attain majority and believes in the proclaimed aim of the society are entitled to become members of the society. But nobody can claim as matter of right. The managing committee is empowered to take proper decision in connection with giving membership.

b) Those who are remit at least hundred rupees in the fund of society become a ordinary member, at least five hundred rupee remitted person become a director post special member. Less than hundred rupees will be treated as Anamath of the society. Those who are remit 100 within two years in not more than four instalments who become considered as a ordinary member. Those who are remit at least five hundred rupees within two years in not more than four instalments who become considered as a director post.



c) Those who are admitted as a member can nominate his legal heirs for continues his membership by approval of governing body; on such nomination this member and president of the society shall be signed in the admission register by enter the names such legal heirs in special column. If a member is expired without nominated his legal heir the governing body can approved the legal heir of this member who has proved the legally successor or real legal heir may think fit.

ADMINISTRATION

There shall be a governing body consisting of ten members including High School Headmaster whereas six members shall elect among this special members of the Director status and three members shall elect among the ordinary members. But the High School Head master is a member without voting power. The governing body shall elect one president, one vice-president and one secretary among themselves. The ordinary members and special members shall elect executive among themselves and the executive committee shall elect the president, vice-president and secretary among themselves shall be through the raising the hand or by ballot and anybody remember demand the election through ballot on such demand shall be complied compulsorily. The Quorum of the executive committees is half of the executive committee members and the necessary quorum for the General body meeting is one fourth of the total members.

(b) The period of the executive committee shall be 2 years But the first election after the registration of the society should be conducted on or before 5-05-1952. There will be a vacancy within the a foresaid period i.e two years in the executive committee shall be filed up in the opinion of the Majority members by copt. But such copted vacancy should be same Staffs as earlier.

(c) The president has responsible to conduct all for and an behalf of the society. The president has entitled to power and liability in the necessary matters of the society to acquire Court decree subject to in control of the executive committee. The president has also power and duly subject to the executive committee to appoint to dismiss the teachers or other staffs any other of high school or in offices or of any other institutions coming under the society, to fix salary, to keep accounts, to manage the High School as manager as representation of the society. But the president has power to supervise Head Masters business in the study matters. And the president has no power in regarding study disciplinary action against students, Assistant teacher. In that matter the High school Headmaster has sole power to do so.



(d) The president and secretary jointly shall be issue receipt for the income to the fund of society. The president and Secretary shall be sign in the cheque for withdrawal of cash from the Bank. The president has duty and power to keep possession of all properties of this society. The vice-president undertakes all the responsibilities of the President in his absence or in leave. All the incoming written documents shall executed in the name of president to the society as well as for and on behalf of the society. As this outgoing all documents to be by the president of the society. The governing body shall pass a special resolution for empowering the president and secretary or any other for managing and departmental correspondence regarding High School matters.

MISCELLANEOUS

1. For election of the members of the next period of the governing body the retiring president shall conduct meeting of members within May 15th of that year. If such meeting was not held, in that case the secretary shall conduct meeting that 30th day of that month and elected new governing body.
2. Notices are to be issued at least 8 days prior to general body meeting, 3 days prior to ordinary executive meeting. For issuing notice by advertisement, individual notice signing in book, notice by post under certificate of posting.
3. The president and vice-president preside over the general body executive meetings. In absence of them the elected member by the governing body who is preside over the meetings.
4. Mark casting vote only when votes are equal.
5. Executive committee meetings are to be convened once in a month. The president has power to convene meeting but in special circumstances or demand the secretary has power to convene the meetings.
6. General body meeting is to be convened in every year within May fifteenth of that year, submit the income and expenditure account and budget for the next year in the meeting.
7. The general body is empowered to amend these byelaws for which the matter of amendment is to be included in the notice and there should be 1/3 majority out of the total members.


